Call to Order: The Regular Meeting of the Braidwood City Council on November 1, 2022 was called to order at 7:00 p.m., by Mayor Jones in the Council Chambers of the Braidwood City Hall.

Mayor's Report: We had a successful Halloween.

Administrator Report: Asked for a motion to approve the purchase of a BC1000 Wood chipper from United Rentals in the amount of \$30,000. Smith asked why we needed to purchase a wood chipper when we have vehicles that need replaced or fixed. Altiery said he knew nothing about vehicles needing replaced, all vehicles are newer and should not need replaced but he would work with Forman Grygiel on them and also explained that having a woodchipper would save the guys a lot of time and would stop them from having to burn trees causing smoke to go into people's homes. Also stated that prior administration didn't buy anything so now this administration is trying to buy the guys new equipment to make their jobs easier. Motion was made by Commissioner Mikel, seconded by Commissioner Money. Motion carried with 4 ayes, 1 nays. (Wietting, Money, Mikel, Jones)

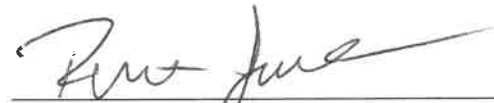
