Public Hearing on Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application of the City of Braidwood

Friday, May 18, 2012

Call to Order

Mayor Bill Rulien called the hearing to order at 2:30p.m. and introduced City Engineer Brian Hertz.

Mr. Hertz explained CDBG. Braidwood's application seeks approximately \$134,000 for a project costing an estimated \$290,000. The project entails replacing water mains on S. Division Street. Ideas for city cost-sharing include using city workers to install the mains and using city Motor Fuel Tax funds to resurface the affected streets. The project perhaps could be performed in three stages.

There are 23 homes in the project area. These homes would benefit from increased water flow and pressure and the elimination of rust from their water.
